

Principal's Award






My Principal's award goes to Both K, Rm 10.

Use a different password for each account No one should be able to guess our passwords Make your password as looong as possible

Tips:

- * A free password manager app like BitWarden can help keep track of all your accounts.
- * The best passwords are **over 10 letters** long, and may contain some numbers or symbols.
 - * Do not use **personal information** like names, pets, or birthdays. These are easy to guess.
 - * To make passwords easier to remember, make them fun! Try a sentence, or song lyrics.
