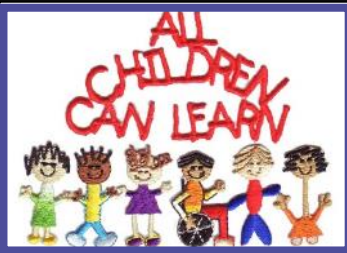

I wish everyone a safe and Happy Christmas and New Year and look forward to working with you all next year.

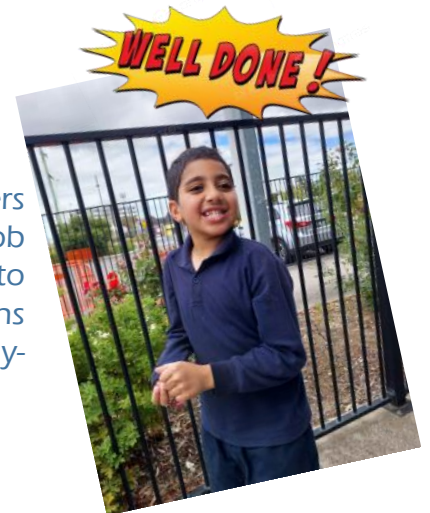
Principal's Award

We love being creative and making things down in EEPS. We can make food, art projects and slime for sensory play.



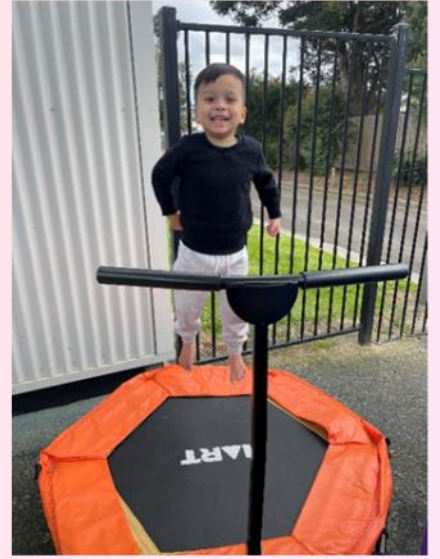

 We have enjoyed participating and learning in many different activities and adventures.

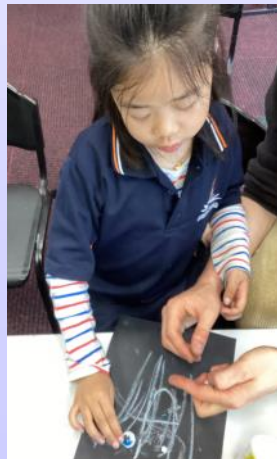




Room 18

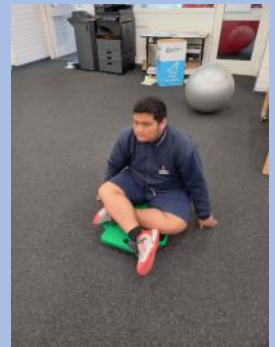
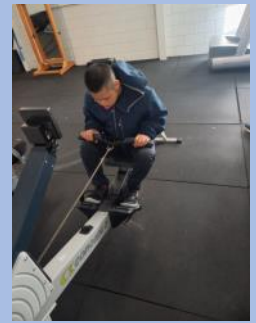
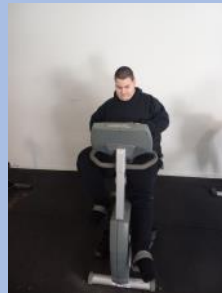


Room 20 students have enjoyed moving their bodies, keeping fit and learning new skills. Fun times on the bike track, Engine room and outdoor obstacle course!
